What You Will See at the  
**Grace Slick Exhibit**  
Fingerhut Gallery Sausalito ~ November 17<sup>th</sup>

Grace Slick's art ranges from soft and cuddly to somewhat outrageous and humorous with a little psychedelic influence mixed in along the way. Grace began drawing as a little girl. She did several Christmas cards and sketches that are the only record of her earliest work. Although she kept sketching and drawing through her life it was not until she stopped singing and decided that this was the best way to continue her communication with the public. Grace began painting professionally in 1999 and has become a major influence in certain corners of the art world. Included in the exhibit will be her most recent paintings that are part of her current tour.

Grace's White Rabbit has led several generations into new worlds of life, love and experimentation. We continue to follow the White Rabbit of curiosity down the Rabbit hole into the unknown. Displaying her ability to capture animals at their best in her drawings, Grace adds a special bit of sarcastic humor into each piece. Many of the pieces she has painted contain the same edge that was in much of her music.

Jimi Hendrix, Jerry Garcia, Janis Joplin and Sting are the subjects of some of the paintings. These portraits have a special quality to them that only Grace can give them. In contrast there are several beautiful nudes done in the classic Sumi style. These drawings and etchings contain a certain sensitivity that instantly draws the viewer into the mood of the piece. By using a wide variety of mediums Grace achieves a range of styles that incorporates Pen, pencil, watercolor, acrylic paint and even some scratchboard pieces. We have incorporated Grace's writings about the pieces into the exhibit so the viewer is able to get into the story and the art a little deeper. This is Grace's way of bringing her viewers down the rabbit hole with her.

We feel that this exhibit presents one of Rock's true icons in a wonderful new light.
